# ADHD AND COMORBID CONDITIONS DISTANCE LEARNING COURSE

## **ABOUT THE COURSE**

This course has been developed by paediatric disability experts at Sheffield Children's NHS Foundation Trust.

After completing the course you will be able to:

- understand the definition of ADHD and its possible aetiologies and synthesise this into clinical practice
- be part of a team involved in assessment and management of children and young people with ADHD and comorbid developmental and mental health difficulties
- critically evaluate local health services and contribute to service development
- make informed judgements within this area, knowing when to ask for help and when refer on
- provide effective advice to education, social care and other agencies

The course should take four months to complete and includes a compulsory study day.

# **Study Day**

Meet with clinicians and fellow learners for a full study day at our centre in Sheffield. The day focuses on:

- the role of the ADHD specialist nurse
- attachment disorder
- current ADHD service issues
