PAEDIATRIC NEURODISABILITY DIPLOMA DISTANCE LEARNING COURSE

ABOUT THE COURSE

Sheffield Children's NHS Foundation Trust and the British Academy of Childhood Disability (BACD) are working in partnership to offer this masters level course.

The course includes 12 units of work split into four modules covering many aspects of paediatric neurodisability:

- communication, networking and an introduction to disability
- epilepsy, cerebral palsies and motor disorders
- learning, developmental and communication disabilities
- sensory impairment and wider aspects of disability

A further module runs concurrently with the modules above and you will be required to undertake an audit or service evaluation.

All of the core modules are relevant to practice and include material prepared by experts, recommended reading and exercises based on the text.

The course can be studied flexibly and trainees may use the course as personal CPD or attain a SCH/BACD diploma qualification.

RESIDENTIALS

There are four residentials of two or two and a half days to attend in Sheffield during the two years of the course.
